Making Every Dollar Count is an eight-lesson financial management curriculum developed by a team of California Cooperative Extension advisors and specialists. This curriculum will help individuals reach self-sufficiency by teaching them, with hands-on activities, the basics of successful money management.

The **Making Every Dollar Count** curriculum utilizes simple, engaging activities to educate low literacy, limited-resource individuals. The ultimate goal is to empower the clients to take control of their finances by giving them the information they need to bring stability to their lives, rather than just living from paycheck to paycheck or crisis to crisis. The curriculum is designed as an enhancement to the Food Stamp Nutrition Education Program (FSNEP).

The curriculum is composed of eight lessons: Setting Goals; Making Choices; Stretch Your Dollars...; Budgeting Basics; Paying Bills on Time; When You Can't Pay Cash; Saving Money on Food; and Food Advertising. Many activities are included so that the participants will "learn by doing." Each lesson contains: a teaching outline; an instructor's guide with information on the use of the handouts and the interactive techniques; and visuals and handouts in both Spanish and English.
